Shekinah Retreat Centre is a ministry of Mennonite Church Saskatchewan. As such our policies and practices are guided by the denominational confession of faith (Confession of Faith in a Mennonite Perspective 1995).

The mission statement of the Shekinah Retreat Centre states that "Shekinah is to be a setting where all who come, have opportunity to experience the presence and glory of God through discovery, reflection, interaction, community and nature". In a practical sense this means we seek to facilitate the meaningful interaction of people with the Creator the wholesome interaction of people with creation and the interaction of people in community.

The facilities at Shekinah are available for rent to those within the denomination, those of other denominations, as well as the general public. We ask that clients who choose to use our facilities respect Our general mission and purpose. We expect that they will abide by the on site rules and regulations which address operational and safety concerns.

The administration of Shekinah Retreat Centre reserves the right to deny the use of the facilities to any rental applicant whose actions are deemed contrary to the mission and purpose for which Shekinah was created. If a deposit has been provided and a rental contract entered into prior to the refusal, Shekinah Retreat Centre will refund the deposit without penalty.
